

Health Requirements

Students must comply with any university-wide health requirements (<http://catalog.northeastern.edu/undergraduate/information-entering-students/health-requirements-uhcs/>).

As a condition of matriculation at Northeastern University, all students are required to submit the completed University Health Report form. Consult the UHCS website (<https://www.northeastern.edu/uhcs/forms/university-health-report/>) for instructions and deadlines to submit the University Health Report form. UHCS may block the registration of those students who do not file the required form(s).

Clinical Clearance

Based on clinical education site requirements and associated clinical affiliation agreements, some programs in the Bouvé College of Health Sciences will require additional medical documentation and health certification. Additional requirements may include, but are not limited to, exam or statement of good health prior to registration, annual proof of physical examination, and/or proof of additional immunities. This "clinical clearance" may be required by some programs prior to engaging in clinical, internship, or fieldwork.
