

Health Requirements—University Health and Counseling Services (UHCS)

All students enrolled in Massachusetts must complete a University Health Report (https://www.northeastern.edu/uhrs/forms/university-health-report/#_ga=26450756712672158041653319963-17748315711653317231) and submit it to University Health and Counseling Services by the stated deadline. The health report is comprised of three sections: demographic information, consent to treat, and the vaccinations required (the Massachusetts School Immunization Requirements for Post-Secondary Institutions). Please complete the first page yourself. The second page must be completed and signed by a healthcare provider who can verify the dates that the required vaccines were administered. The last two pages review the meningitis vaccine and waiver. Students who fail to submit a completed health report will be unable to complete future course registration.

All vaccination information will be entered into the Massachusetts Immunization and Information System. This system allows immunization information to be portable between providers, accessible during an emergency, and allows the patient to access the information as needed. Additional documentation of immunity is mandatory for students in Bouvé College of Health Sciences. Students should check with their program advisor or placement supervisor for more information.
