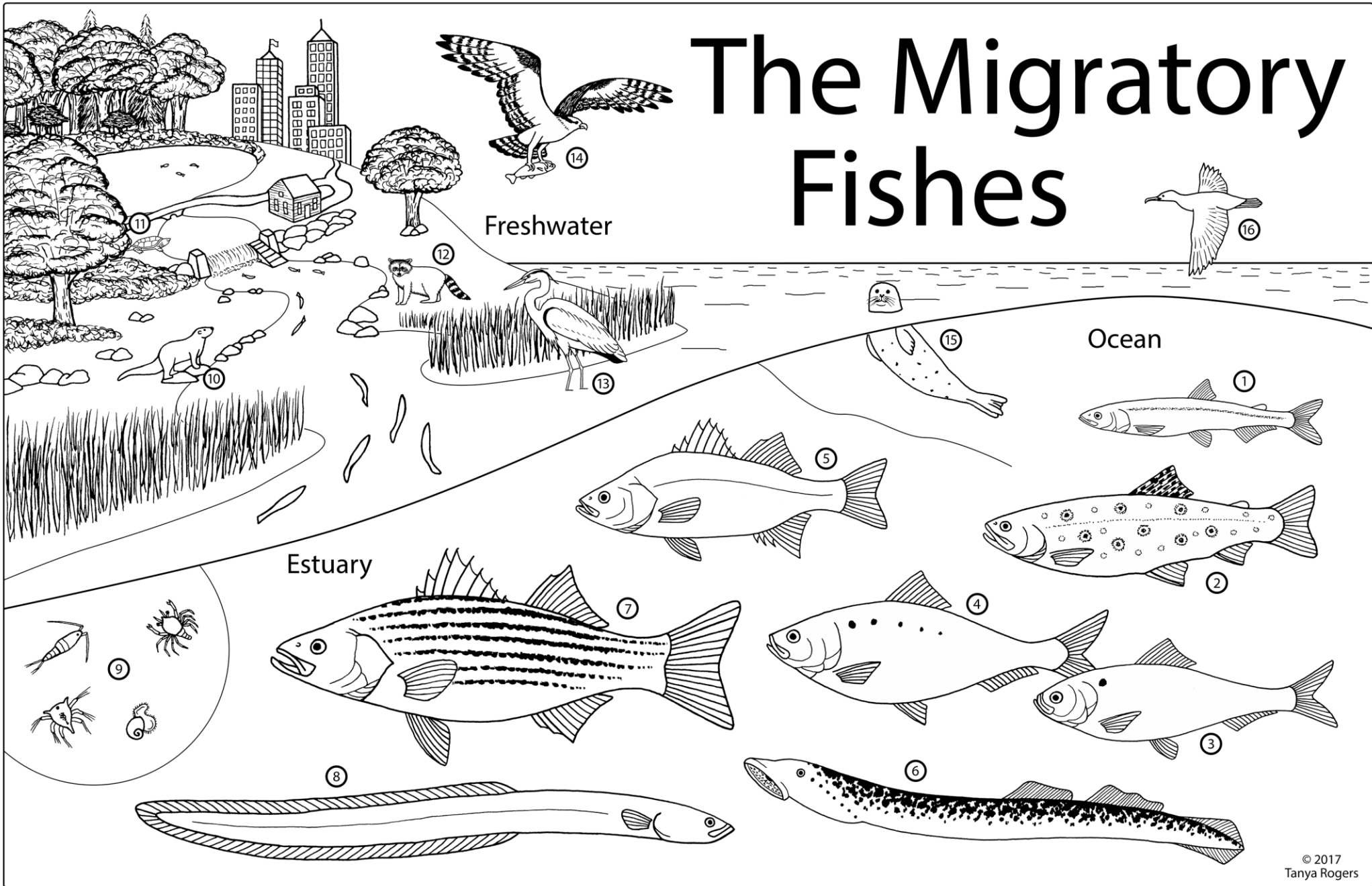

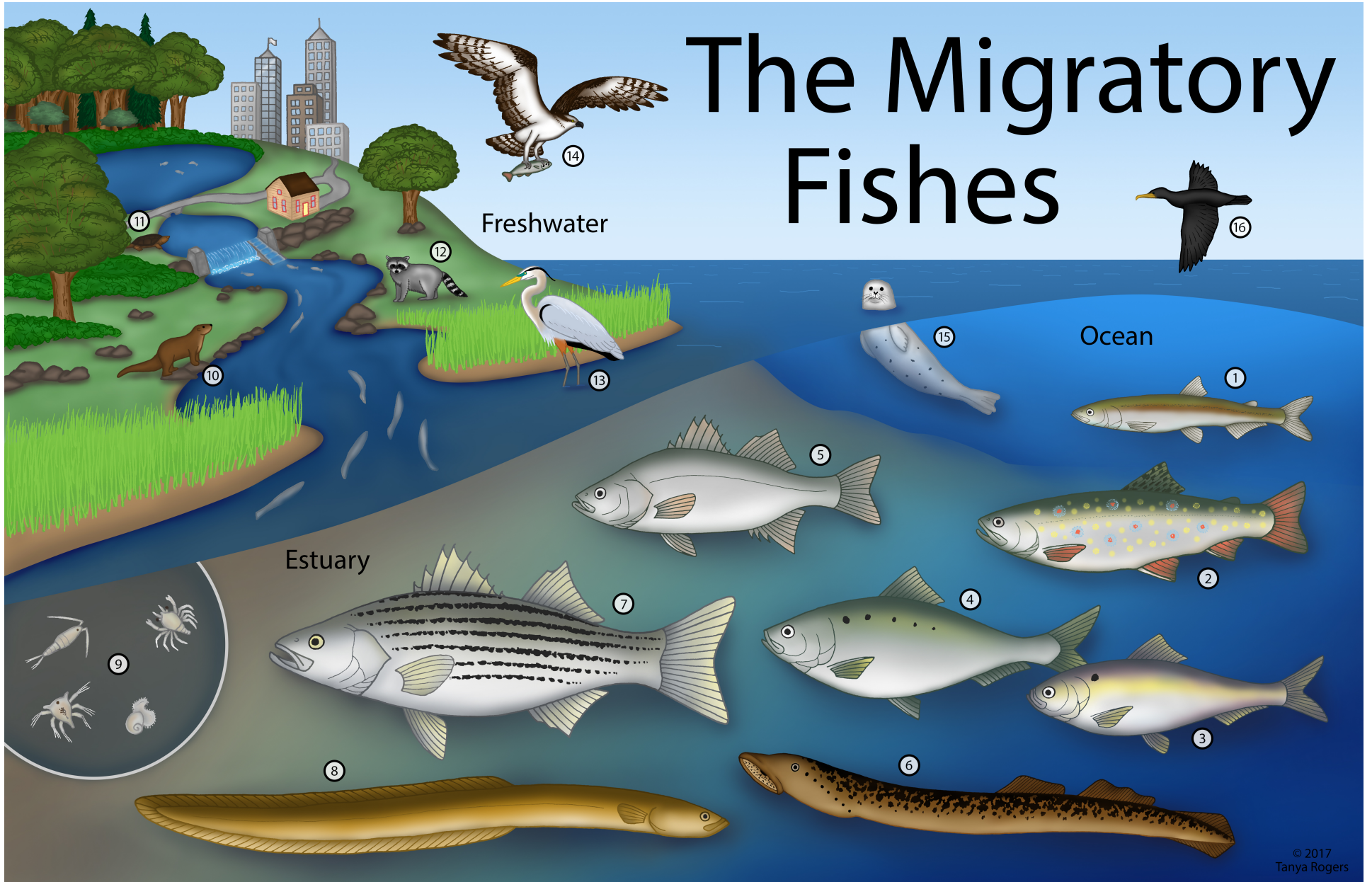

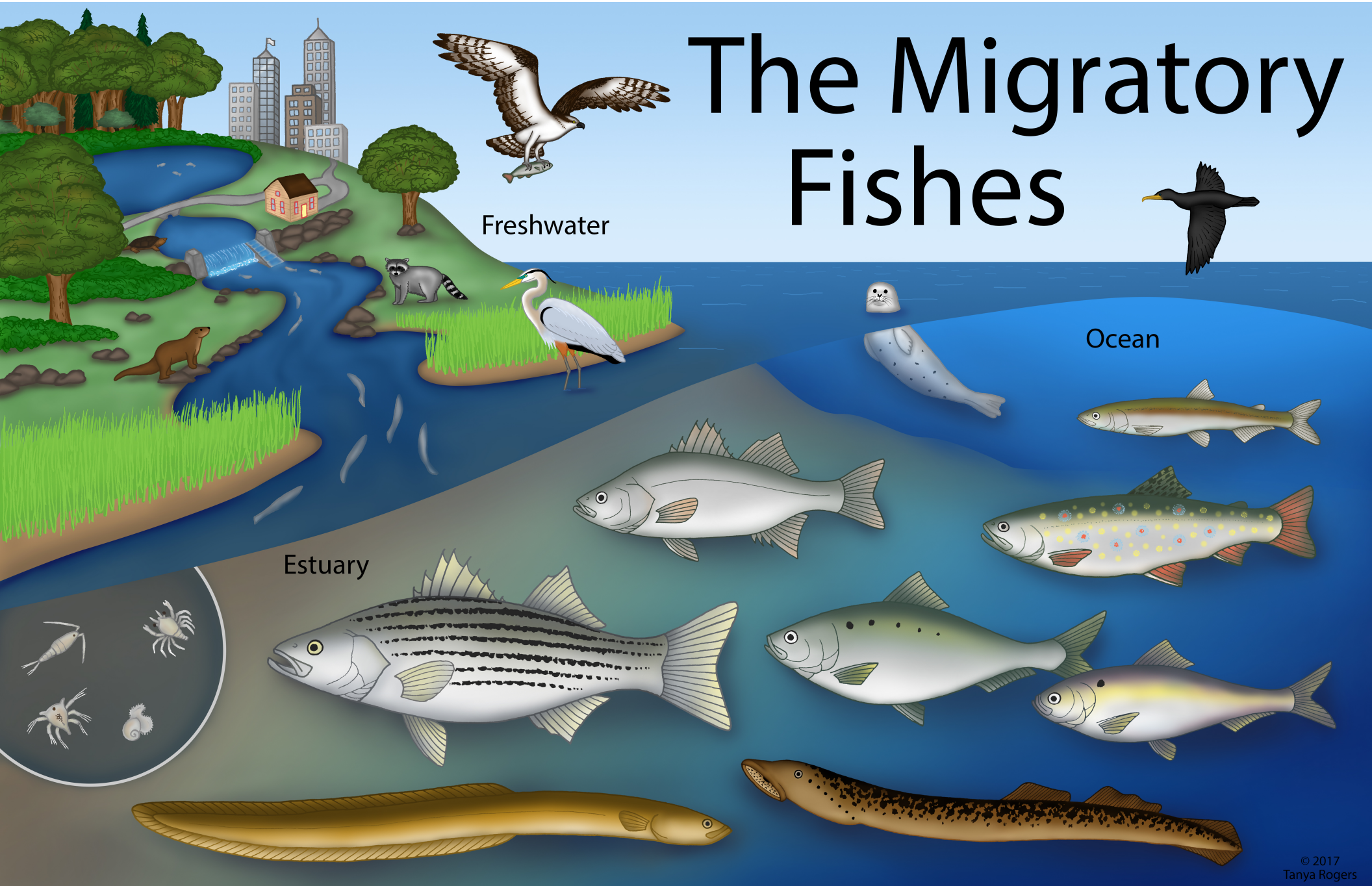

5	White perch	<i>Morone americana</i>
6	Sea lamprey	<i>Petromyzon marinus</i>
7	Striped bass	<i>Morone saxatilis</i>
8	American eel	<i>Anguilla rostrata</i>
