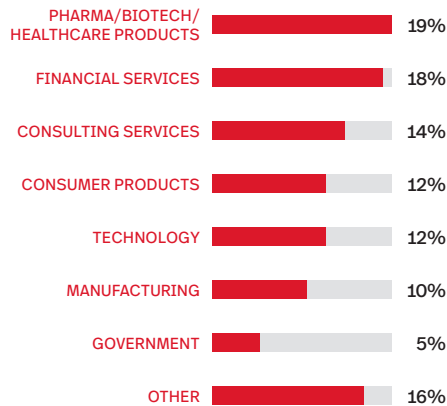
Employment Statistics

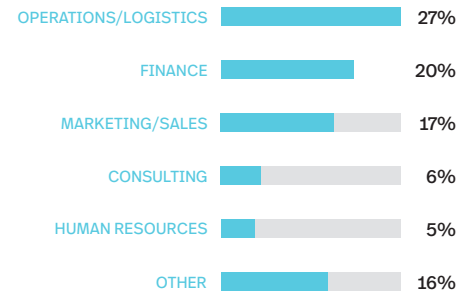

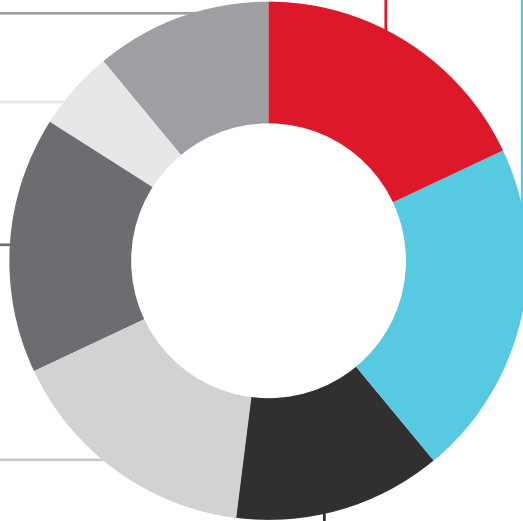
