Husky 101 Student and Family Orientation

Husky 101 Orientation is *mandatory for students* and *optional for families*. Students will attend their mandatory session *the day following their assigned move-in date*. The optional Family Orientation will follow the same sequence.

- Thursday, January 5 or Friday, January 6 (dependent upon the student's move-in date)
- *Pre-registration is NOT required*. Check-in will take place on the morning of the program.
