Orientation Parking Instructions

Complimentary day parking is available in Northeastern's **795 Columbus Avenue Garage, Boston, MA, 02120**. On each day of Orientation (January 5 and 6), the garage will be open from 7:00 a.m. – 11:00 p.m.; no overnight parking will be available. *Parking instructions for Move-in will be sent from [Housing Services](#).*

Instructions:

- Upon entry, **pull a ticket**.
- When exiting, **first scan your Entry Ticket, and then the barcode below**, which will also be available at Check-in. Scanning the barcode will remove the fee and open the gate.
- **Please note:** we're unable to validate parking tickets from other university pay garages.

Husky 101 Student and Family Orientation Check-in

Husky 101 Orientation is *mandatory for students* and *optional for families*. Students will attend their mandatory session *the day following their assigned move-in date*. The optional Family Orientation will follow the same sequence.

Family Orientation Check-in:

7:00 – 8:00 a.m. in the [Curry Student Center Indoor Quad](#), first floor

Continental breakfast will be provided.

- **Thursday, January 5 or Friday, January 6** (based on your student's assigned move-in date).
- Pre-registration is NOT required. Check-in will take place on the morning of the program. [Click here](#) for the Family Orientation schedule. Detailed program schedules will be distributed at Check-in.
- Once your student begins the Orientation experience, your time with them will be limited. On Friday evening, students will be engaged in one of our signature events, the Winter Blast. Then it's off to a **fully packed weekend** of activities designed to acclimate your students to campus and their new city, Boston!

If you're on a meal plan, visit the dining hall prior to Check-in.

- Thursday, January 5 or Friday, January 6 (based on your assigned move-in date).
- Pre-registration is NOT required; **attendance is mandatory**.

- Mandatory Husky 101 Orientation will run from 12:00 – 5:00 p.m. EST on the date following your assigned move-in. Additional optional sessions will take place on Saturday, January 7. Detailed program schedules will be distributed at check-in.
