

#### Institutional Certifications and Assurances

- Northeastern University, as a grantee, provides at the time of proposal submission and throughout the life-cycle of an award certification and assurances that it is in full compliance with all relevant laws, rules and regulations.
- How each grantee implements its research management responsibilities varies but all grantees should include documented practices that address specific regulatory requirements.
- Some regulations required that the grantee monitor the covered activity; monitoring involves verification and tracking of compliance with a specific term or condition of the award.

#### RESPONSIBLE CONDUCT OF RESEARCH


Funding Agencies require that Institutions (grantees) receiving awards have in place policies and procedures to safeguard the integrity of scientific research.

NSF and NIH's implementation of the 2007 America COMPETES Act mandates RCR training.

RCR training is designed to promote ethical research, encourage best practices and increase an investigator's understanding of the regulatory standards applicable to research.

#### RESPONSIBLE CONDUCT OF RESEARCH

- 6. Collaborative Science
- 7. Data Acquisition, Management
- 8. Authorship
- 9. Peer Review

### Mentor/Trainee

The goal of research training is to produce the next generation of productive, independent investigators.

PIs are responsible for preparing RCR training plans and individual development plans (IDPs).


#### RESEARCH ADMINISTRATION

- ✓ Review each FOA to determine if RCR requirements apply;
- ✓ At time of award acceptance advise PI of RCR requirements; and
- ✓ Throughout the award verify and track RCR compliance.
