

2023–2024 Financial Aid Checklist

For Returning Undergraduate Students

- Complete the [Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#) using 2021 tax year information. The 2023–2024 FAFSA opens on **October 1** and the priority filing deadline is **April 1**.

 - > If eligible, use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, which allows you and your parent(s) to access IRS tax return information and transfer the required data to your FAFSA.*
- Respond promptly to any request for additional documentation. If you have been selected for verification and additional documentation is necessary, you must submit these materials before a financial aid award can be prepared.
- Awards will be available beginning **mid-July** for students who have provided all required financial aid application materials. Once awards are available, they will be posted to the Northeastern [Student Hub](#), and students will be notified via their Northeastern email account. Financial aid awards will continue to be prepared on a rolling basis for students who complete the financial aid application process.
- Review your award and contact our office if your enrollment plans change or if you choose to cancel or reduce a portion of your financial aid.
- New loan borrowers must complete necessary documentation (if accepting loans). Documents may include Federal Student Loan Entrance Counseling, Master Promissory Note, Self-Certification Form, and Title IV Credit Authorization.
- Notify our office if you will be receiving other forms of financial assistance not reflected on your financial aid award, such as [outside scholarships](#).
- Secure [financing options](#), such as supplemental loans, or enroll in the monthly payment plan by the due date.
